

## Garbage Pick-up for Atlas Township is Wednesday Morning

Residents trash and recycling service is provided by Emterra (1-877-609-6753) Trash and recycling services are provided weekly and must be at the curb by 7:00 am. Official Holidays that fall during the week will delay garbage pick-up by one day. Please call Emterra for information regarding special items, acceptable materials, or complaints. They will not pick up trash bags or containers heavier than 50#, or trash that has been spilled or shredded by local critters, or vandals. Garbage workers are people too. They are not your personal cleaning crew. Be considerate of how you store and bag your garbage and be a good neighbor by picking up spills and taking in your cans when emptied. Keep your containers clean.

On Recycling: DO NOT PLACE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS INTO YOUR RECYCLE BIN: DIRTY DIAPERS, HYGIENE PRODUCTS, CARRY-OUT CONTAINERS WITH FOOD STILL INSIDE, OR ANY CONTAINERS THAT HAVE NOT BEEN EMPTIED AND RINSED. Latex paint will be picked up if the lids are removed and the paint is dried out.

Burn permits issued in 2020 expired on 12-31-20

Please visit: atlastownhip.org and click on "Burn Permit" to apply, or stop by the Atlas Township office.

Burn permits are issued for the entire calendar year in which they were applied for.

There is no charge to obtain a burn permit. Burn permits are required for any type of outside/outdoor burning in Atlas Township or the Village of Goodrich. If it has a flame and/or creates smoke, a permit is required.

### **Prescription Drug Disposal**

The Genesee County Sheriff's Department has a collection receptacle located in the Atlas Township Office for the collection of prescriptions drugs residents wish to dispose of.



#### MAILBOX SIZE AND **CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS**

A mailbox with the Postmaster General's (PMG) seal of approval meets USPS size and construction standards. If you build your own mailbox or buy a custom-made one, it must meet the PMG standards. Show your local postmaster your mailbox plans or your custom-made box for approval.

#### Where to Place the Mailbox:

Here are some helpful guidelines to follow when placing your mailbox:

· Position your mailbox 41" to 45" from the road surface to the bottom of the mailbox or point of mail entry.

· Place your mailbox 6" to 8" back from the curb. If you do not have a raised curb, contact your local postmaster for guidance.

 Put your house or apartment number on the mailbox.

· If your mailbox is on a different street from your house or apartment, put your full street address on the box.

Mailbox installation requirement: Place the mailbox 6 to 8 inches in from the curb. Dig the post hole so you can bury the mailbox post with 41 to 45 inches of mailbox post showing above the ground.

**Installing the Mailbox Post:** 

The best mailbox supports are stable but bend or fall away if a car hits them. The Federal Highway Administration recommends:

 A 4" x 4" wooden support or a 2"-diameter standard steel or aluminum pipe.

 vAvoid unyielding and potentially dangerous supports, like heavy metal pipes, concrete posts, and farm equipment (e.g., milk cans filled with concrete).

Bury your post no more than 24" deep.
