



Residents trash and recycling service is provided by Emterra (1-877-609-6753) Trash and recycling services are provided weekly and must be at the curb by 7:00 am. Official Holidays that fall during the week will delay garbage pick-up by one day. Please call Emterra for information regarding special items, acceptable materials, or complaints. They will not pick up trash bags or containers heavier than 50#, or trash that has been spilled or shredded by local critters, or vandals. Garbage workers are people too. They are not your personal cleaning crew. Be considerate of how you store and bag your garbage and be a good neighbor by picking up spills and taking in your cans when emptied. Keep your containers clean.

On Recycling: DO NOT PLACE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS INTO YOUR RECYCLE BIN: DIRTY DIAPERS, HYGIENE PRODUCTS, CARRY-OUT CONTAINERS WITH FOOD STILL INSIDE, OR ANY CONTAINERS THAT HAVE NOT BEEN EMPTIED AND RINSED. Laytex paint will be picked up if the lids are removed and the paint is dried out.

# Michigan winters ... and the roads in Atlas Township.

Winter in Michigan is a special season, a time when our state's great beauty is enhanced by nature's handiwork - snow and ice. Winter also presents special problems for motorists and residents. Genesee County Road Commission wants to help make your winter driving safer and more enjoyable while giving you information that will help serve you better. The Genesee County Road Commission (GCRC) is responsible for clearing 411 miles of state trunk lines, 478 miles of county primary roads, 289 miles of paved county local roads and 346 miles of gravel county roads. Critical routes and those that handle high traffic volumes are given first attention. Only after those routes are judged to be safe and passable are the remaining streets and roads plowed. These streets make up a remaining 459 miles requiring maintenance for the GCRC.

The Atlas Garage covers three (3) townships: Atlas, Davison and Grand Blanc. Five (5) GCRC employees work out of this garage. This garage covers 327.38 miles of County Primary and Local roads plus I-69, I-75 as well as M-15.

#### **Priorities:**

First priority - Expressways: I-75, and I-69 as well as M-15 Second priority - County primary roads: Gale, Perry, Irish, Baldwin and Hill

Third priority - County section line local roads:
For example: Coolidge and Green

Fourth priority - Remaining County local roads and subdivision streets (county maintained)

Winter does more damage to our roads than any other single force. In fact, 30 percent of the GCRC budget is used for winter maintenance and to repair the effects of winter's ravages on the road system. There are nearly 1,800 miles of roads in Genesee County, which takes about 5 days to plow under normal conditions. Plowing both sides of the county's roads is the equivalent of plowing a road from Flint to Key West, Florida, and back again. the GCRC's general policy is to salt until snow accumulates then plow. Sometimes salting and plowing are done at the same time. Salt is the fastest, safest method for clearing roads because by melting ice and snow, the end result of water can run-off. However, when temperatures reach 10 degrees or lower, even salt is ineffective, so drivers must be extra cautious. Critical and priority routes are re-salted as necessary as are bridges, curves, hills, overpasses and intersections. Because salt does not work on gravel roads, limited amounts of sand and slag are used on hills, curves and stopping areas. These materials do not melt snow, but provide temporary traction.
