Do Your Neighbors Consider Your Treasures Trash?

It's the time of the year for lawn mowing and yard clean up. Be considerate of your neighbors and our community by keeping your yard and your "treasures" tidy.

Atlas Township has a Blight Ordinance that regulates dangerous, unsanitary, obnoxious or unsightly conditions upon premises or vacant lands or public rightsof-way within Atlas Township, Failures to abide by these regulations are enforced at the property owner's or occupant's expense.

It is the duty of every owner or occupant to be responsible for keeping their premises in a clean and inhabitable condition and to prevent any nuisance. Nuisances are: dilapidated structures other than residences, obnoxious growths and overgrowth of weeds and grasses in excess of six (6) inches on occupied lots or twelve (12) inches on vacant lands, obnoxious accumulations or heaps of animal, vegetable or mineral matter or by the presence of any other offensive material to such an extent as to constitute a public nuisance within the meaning of the common law or statutes of the State of Michigan.

It is the duty of every occupant/owner of every premise or vacant land and the owner of unoccupied premises to cut and remove or destroy by lawful means all such weeds, grass or rank obnoxious or harmful vegetation as often as may be necessary to comply with the provisions of the ordinance. Please be a good neighbor, keep your lawn mowed!

Atlas Township has and enforces the ordinance pertaining to automotive vehicles or trailers of any kind without current license plates and/or inoperable condition that are parked or stored on any residentially zoned property other than in completely enclosed buildings.

File of Life Information **Cards Available**

File of Life information cards are available at the Atlas Township Office for township residents; designed especially for our senior population or anyone at risk. Medical emergencies can happen to



anyone at any time. In medical emergencies there is often panic, confusion, fear and a sense of urgency and helplessness. The File of Life is a card which contains vital personal medical information and is kept on the outside of the resident's refrigerator in a bright red magnetic plastic pocket. This location is readily accessible to emergency personnel when they arrive on an emergency call. The medical card lists the resident's emergency medical contacts, health/physical problems, medications, allergies, recent surgeries and more. A door decal is placed on the outside of the main entry door to notify arriving emergency personnel that this information is available inside the residence. With the File of Life card there is solid information on conditions and medications; it is written down and ready to be utilized by responding emergency personnel. This very simple concept of providing necessary information has saved dozens of lives. It is the responsibility of the resident (or their family) to maintain current information on the File of Life card. These cards are available at the Township offices at no cost to Atlas Township residents.

A one percent (1%) interest penalty per month will be applied beginning September 15, 2022. Summer 2022 taxes may be paid to the Atlas Township Treasurer's office through February 28, 2023 with interest penalty. Please contact the Atlas Township Treasurer's office for the amount due including penalty if paying after September 14, 2022.

Personal Property Tax Payers

If you are a business owner registered within Atlas Township and are receiving personal property tax statements/bills you could be exempt if you have less than \$80,000 of value in fixtures and equipment. Please be certain to complete and return the personal property tax statement form you receive. If you are no longer in business you must notify Atlas Township Assessor in writing prior to December 30, 2022.
