- · The Permanent Absentee Ballot Application List is being phased out by the end of 2024.
- · Voters currently on the Permanent Application List are encouraged to join the Permanent Ballot List.
- Absentee Ballot Applications sent in 2024 will include a checkbox to join the Permanent Ballot List.
- · Voters on the Permanent Ballot List will be mailed a ballot for every election to the address on file.
- U.S. POST OFFICE CANNOT FORWARD BALLOTS, eventually they'll be returned to the Clerk's Office.
- The Clerk's Office will not be allowed to send any ballot application once a voter joins the Permanent Ballot List
- Presidential Primaries require voters to select a ballot style (Republican, Democrat, or Non-Partisan). Ordinarily the selection would be made on the Absentee Ballot Application form. For voters on the Permanent Ballot List there will be a Presidential Primary Ballot Selection form mailed instead.
