

221.000 - VISIBLE HOUSE NUMBERS TO AID EMERGENCY VEHICLES Ord. No. 88-02 Adopted: May 16, 1988

An Ordinance to require clearly visible house numbers to aid emergency vehicles.

THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ATLAS ORDAINS:

221.001 - Visible numbers affixed to dwelling.

Sec. 1. Each residential dwelling within the Township of Atlas shall have affixed to it a clearly visible house number which may be seen by the drivers of emergency vehicles including, but not limited to police, fire and ambulance services.

221.002 - Violation.

Sec. 2. Any owner and/or occupant, who occupies or allows another person to occupy a dwelling which does not have visible house numbers shall be in violation of this Ordinance.

221.003 - Penalties.

Sec. 3. Violation of this ordinance is a municipal civil infractions. In addition to pursuing a municipal civil infraction proceeding, the Township may also institute an appropriate action in a court of competent jurisdiction seeking injunctive, declaratory, or other equitable relief to enforce or interpret this Ordinance or any provision of the Ordinance. All remedies available to the Township under this Ordinance and Michigan law shall be deemed to be cumulative and not exclusive. Each day a violation of this ordinance shall exist shall be deemed a separate offense. In addition to a fine to be determined by the township board, the court, at its discretion, may award other costs, attorney's fees, damages, expenses and other remedies as provided by law.

221.004 - Effective date.

Sec. 4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and publication.
