90.001 - Misrepresentation of price prohibited.

<u>Sec. 1</u>. No person shall alter, transfer, remove, replace, conceal or otherwise misrepresent the price at which merchandise is offered for sale in or near a store during its business hours, with the intent to avoid paying any or all of the posted price of the merchandise.

90.002 - Stealing prohibited.

<u>Sec. 2</u>. No person shall steal merchandise in or near a store during its business hours.

90.003 - Fraud prohibited.

<u>Sec. 3</u>. No person shall obtain or attempt to obtain money or merchandise from or near a store during its business hours by exchanging or attempting to exchange merchandise which was not sold by or purchased from the store.

90.004 - Penalties.

<u>Sec. 4</u>. Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or may be imprisoned for not more than 90 days or both.

90.005 - Effective date.

<u>Sec. 5</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after it is published as an adopted ordinance.
